Amendment to Racing Instructions

28-May-09

1 General

Due to the confined nature of the club's racing area, any boat racing under the flag of MBSC must be crewed by a minimum of Two competent persons. The only exception is single handed dinghies, e.g. lasers

2 All cruisers

All cruisers intending to race in a club race will advise, within 15 minutes prior to the first gun, that they are in the vicinity of the start and are intending to race. This will be done on VHF Channel 8 to the MBSC race officer.

The yacht will indicate the yacht name and sail number.

The race officer will acknowledge this as the yachts race entry.

Prior to the first gun the race officer will announce to the fleet the expected movement of commercial traffic in the vicinity of the race course for the expected duration of the race.

The race officer will then inform the fleet of the course set for the race.

Failure to preadvise the race officer will deem the yacht to have not approached the start. The yacht will not be deemed to be racing.

The yacht's times will not be recorded and the yacht will not be given a result.

3 All dinghies

All dinghies racing under the flag of MBSC will be notified, on the same notice board which contains the planned race course, of the expected movement of commercial traffic in the vicinity of the race course for the expected duration of the race.

4 All Race Officers

All race officers will be expected to bear in mind the above amendments and will be expected to inform themselves, by way of VHF or phone to "Port Ops".
